


Roswitha's Cilliolk Dance - practised for the first time  
17. Sept. 1986

Square set - 1 man between 2 women (a triplet) facing each other across the set



1-4 Heads adv. & retire

5-8 Sides repeat 1-4

9-16 All MM R H across || all WW dance swing (the 2 first ladies: & L H H across together, also all the other ladies)

MM finish back to back in the centre to face their 2 WW  
17-24 All the MM dance R H H & L H H teapots with their WW and finish back to back in the middle again

25-28 The men set to their L H - Lady & to their R H - lady

29-32 All the Men dance a Pétançon turn towards the Right (= clock-wise direction) to face two other WW

33-36 All MM set to the new L H W & the new R H W

37-40 All the MM dance half circle to the L with those new ladies when the MM are facing into the circle R H W & L H W drop their nearer H H, and pulling towards themselves, the Men turn the Ladies under their raised arms to form the big circle

41-48 All circle round and back

Note: In every repetition the men progress 1 place in clock-wise direction - while the WW stay on their original places all the time.

It is suggested that the dance is repeated until all the men are back there where they started the dance
