

## The Freiburg Scottish Country Dancers' Frolic

Dance for 3 couples in a 3 couple longwise set, 3 × 32 bars, Strathspey.

- 1 – 8 1<sup>st</sup> couple set, dance petronella, set and turn  $\frac{3}{4}$  with both hands to finish in partner's place.
- 9 – 16 1<sup>st</sup> couple in opposite places and 2<sup>nd</sup> couple dance 4 bars of a 'modified Espagnole' to finish 2, 1x, 3:  
1<sup>st</sup> lady and 2<sup>nd</sup> man dance across the set to partners' places to finish facing each other, while 1<sup>st</sup> man and 2<sup>nd</sup> lady cross by the right (2<sup>nd</sup> lady preceding 1<sup>st</sup> man) to finish facing away from each other.  
2<sup>nd</sup> lady and 1<sup>st</sup> man dance across the set to the opposite places, while 1<sup>st</sup> lady and 2<sup>nd</sup> man cross by the left (1<sup>st</sup> lady preceding 2<sup>nd</sup> man). All finish facing in.  
1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> couple dance half four hands round anticlockwise: 2, 3x, 1.  
1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> couple set, 3<sup>rd</sup> couple cross by the right: 2, 3, 1.
- 17 – 24 All set and link twice: 1x, 3x, 2x.
- 25 – 32 All chase half way round to left, turn partner by the right and advance and retire.  
Repeat from new positions.
